The Purple Leaf Education Programme (funded by West Mercia Police and Crime Commissioner) increases young people's awareness of sexual abuse, harassment, and exploitation. It equips them with the skills, knowledge, and tools to be able to identify healthy and unhealthy relationships and behaviours and to know where to go for help and support

The key learning objectives of the programme are shown below

Your understanding of what is meant by sexual violence will increase.

Your understanding of healthy and unhealthy relationships will increase, including understanding grooming

Your understanding of consent will increase, including consent for sending/receiving nudes.

You will know how to access information and support for you or a friend if you need it or if you are just feeling unsure about something.

Our programme at Fairfield High School will be delivered over 3 sessions of 60 minutes. It will be delivered by two facilitators, both of whom are subject matter experts in this field. The sessions are mostly discussion based, with some short activities and are designed to provide young people with information which is factual, non judgemental, uses correct terminology and is in an accessible format.

Support available

Support is available during and after the session to anyone who needs it. We will also ensure that the students are aware of the different types of support available to them at every session.
