**Year 10 Geography and Art GCSE July 7<sup>th</sup> – July 8<sup>th</sup> 2023**

The Geography and Art department are looking forward to the joint residential trip to Liverpool on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

We will **depart** from school at **7.00 am on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July** and would appreciate it if students could be at school by **6.45 am**. We will **return** to school on **Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> July at 6.30 pm** where a prompt pick up will be required. We will keep you informed of any time changes/delays on our journey home via text messages so please check for updates.

We will be doing a study of Albert Docks regeneration project, where we will be staying at the Youth Hostel. On Friday morning, we will be first visiting Crosby Beach (famous for '**Another Place**', the sculpture by internationally acclaimed artist, Antony Gormley) after which we will be visiting the Tate Modern and the Maritime museums, followed by a river cruise on the Mersey. After our journey on the Mersey, we will be going to look at the regeneration project of Chavasse Park and Liverpool One shopping centre, which are both study areas of Geography urban redevelopment. At Liverpool One students will have a little time to do some retail therapy should they wish to and therefore may want to bring some money or a debit card. We shall then return to the Youth Hostel for our evening meal and some down time.

On Saturday morning, we will be doing a walking tour of other sites of Liverpool including the Baltic Triangle, China Town and Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral, before heading back to the dockland for a guided tour up the Liver Building where good views across the city can be seen. After this we will be have a guided tour of Anfield Park. There is an opportunity to have a green screen memory photo here so if students want to partake - please do not wear green!

As we are only going for one night, we would be grateful if students could travel light. They will need a water bottle with them and a packed lunch for the Friday (students in receipt of free school meals will have a lunch provided). Students should wear layers of clothing in case of temperature changes and bring a waterproof coat and sun cream if the weather forecast is for wet or hot weather. Students will be doing a lot of walking so will need comfortable shoes with a good grip e.g. trainers. Any medication that your child needs please make sure that they pack and clearly label it.
